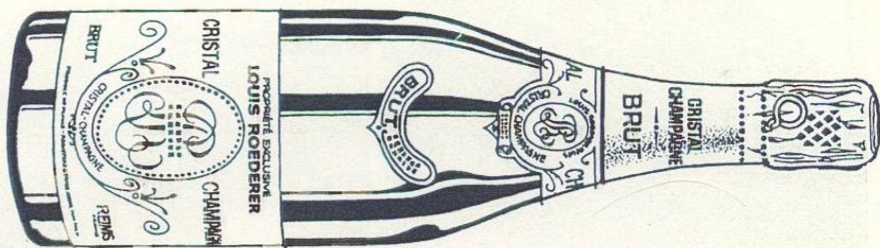

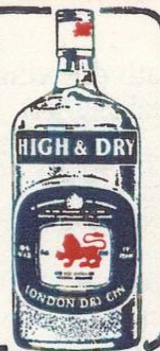

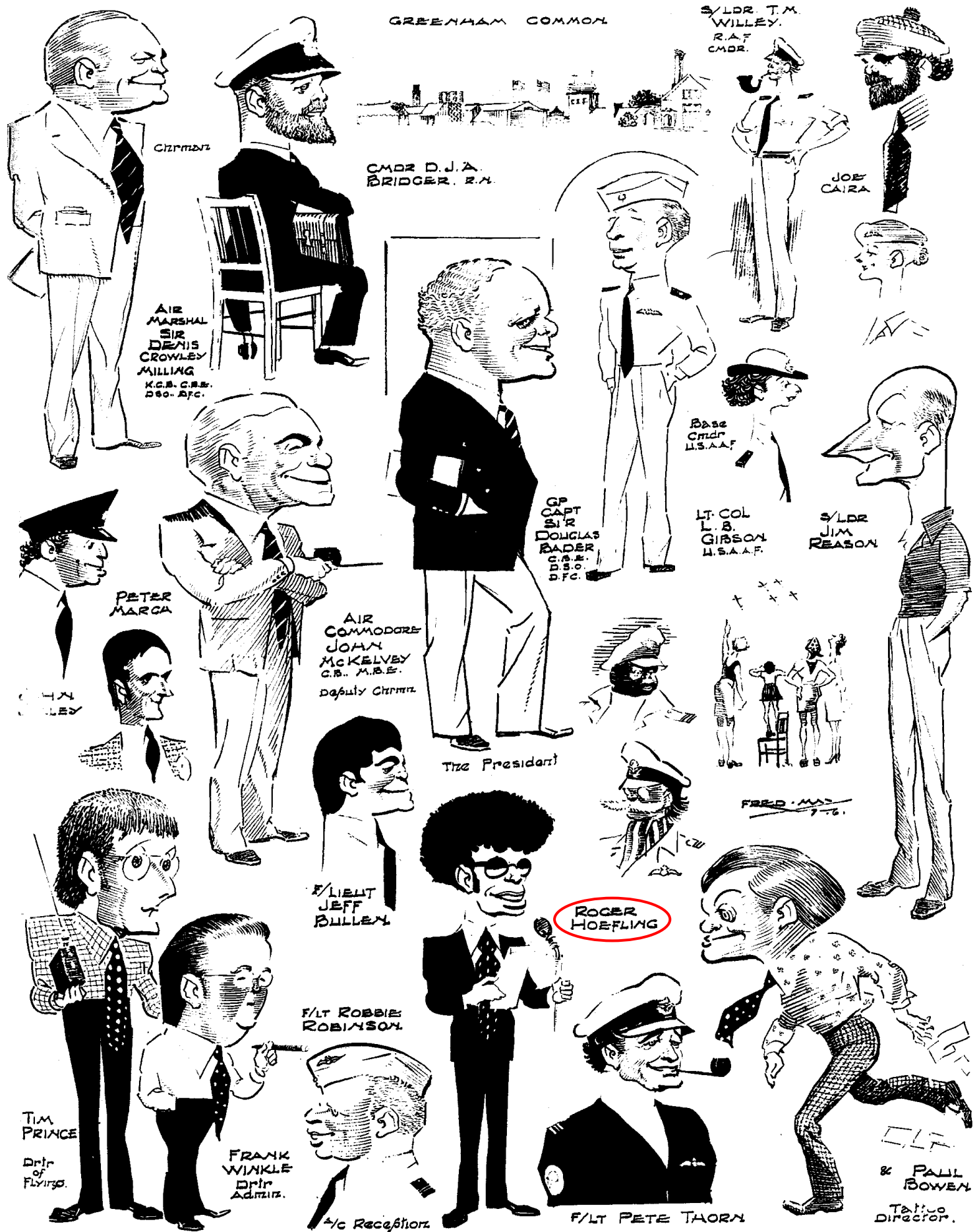

FRED MAY AT THE INTERNATIONAL AIR TATTOO



Cartoon artist Fred May recently attended the International Air Tattoo at Greenham Common, Newbury, and sketched some of those responsible for the direction, production and administration of an Air Tattoo of such magnitude.

The International Air Tattoo is staged for the benefit of the Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund, which last year spent £1½ million on the relief of distress among present and past members of the Royal Air Force, as well as widows, dependants and the disabled.
