

AI's roving team of reporters give their verdict on the Air Fete at Mildenhall and the Fighter Meet at North Weald



AIR FETE 97

Four weeks following Nellis' Golden Air Tattoo, it was the turn of RAF Mildenhall, Suffolk, to stage the official European commemoration of the USAF's 50th anniversary.

The sharp and frosty weekend of 24-25 May in East Anglia was as much a contrast with the heat and dust of Nevada as could be achieved, but the sky stayed clear for 20 military air arms representing 16 countries to pay tribute to the USAF's 'Golden Legacy and Boundless

Future'. Six international aerobatic teams, headed by the *Thunderbirds* making their first single-show overseas deployment in their history, along with the first public appearance in the UK by the Northrop Grumman B-2A Spirit, guaranteed that Team Mildenhall received a record 200,000-plus Saturday crowd figure.

Sweden, Hungary and Slovenia became the latest countries to send military aircraft to the Air Fete, the latter nation being one of the best kept secret surprises promised this year by co-ordinato Roger Hoefling. Highlights of a very full and imaginative static display was a line of Boeing C-135 variants, including an impressive three-ship Offutt AFB, Nebraska. USAF's Golden Jubilee may have over-shadowed the military Boeing 707's 40th anniversary but was not forgotten by Team Mildenhall.
